What will you do?

Training will take place in an activity based, problem solving setting rather than a typical classroom setting.

Students will discover how they can participate in the transition process.

Participants will learn about leadership and independence during outdoor adventure activities that promote and encourage development of confidence through ropes courses and other team building activities.
