Getting there:

- * From I-35 in south Austin, exit onto Slaughter Lane and head west.
- * Look for Yarsa Blvd. or Palace Parkway on your right side, then look to your left side.
- * Prepare to turn left, immediately after some apartments near the park entrance.
- * Turn left into the entrance and follow the road all the way to the back where the parking area is. (You will pass the small radio airport on your left side)
- * When you are on the parking lot, you will easily see the pavilion and the flying hands.

MORE INFORMATION ON THIS PARK

This 344-acre park includes a picnic pavilion, volleyball courts, a disc golf course, a nature interpretation center, baseball field, basketball and tennis courts, soccer field, 1.5 miles of hiking and bicycle trails, an equestrian center and a two-mile equestrian trail, a model airplane field, and a fully accessible fishing pier on Slaighter Creek.
