

1. For large mouth limit is 16" - 24" slot bass 16 inches and less 24 inches or greater in length be retained. Only one bass 24 inches or greater may be retained each day.
2. Fishermen bring in more than 5 bass. The largest bass will be rejected. Contestants bring bass less than legal size limit to the weight-in will have fish disqualified from the tournament.
3. Half lbs (8) ounces will be deducted from the total weight for each dead bass presented for weight-in..
4. All bass must be brought in a plastic bag with water.
5. No fishing is allowed from outside of your boat or within 50 yards of another anchored or tied boat that has its occupants. No fishing within boat ramp/boat inspect area.
6. All Federal state and local laws must be obey or contestant will be disqualified. Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation are expected of each contest.
7. All protest must be made on writing within 30 minutes of the final weight-in and submit to the president.
8. In case of tie, prizes money will be divided equally between the tied winning fishermen.
9. coast guard approval life vest must be worn with safety kill switch attached. while your boat is on plane. Safety cushion is required.
10. Any contestant that violates any tournament rule will be disqualified.
11. One or Two fishermen in boat is allowed.
12. wading tube and bank fishing are allowed.
